1) Portfolio Inventory Page (Notion / Website)

Create a table with the following columns:

- **Project Title**
- **Business Problem**
- **Domain** (Sales / HR / Churn / Finance / Marketing / Supply Chain)
- **Data Source** (Kaggle / Gov portal / Mock)
- **Tech Used** (Power BI / DAX / Power Query / Python optional)
- **Key KPIs**
- **Link to Dashboard**
- **Link to GitHub**
- **Status** (Draft / In Review / Published)

2) Project Write-up Template

Project Title:

Domain: Sales / HR / Marketing / Finance / Supply Chain

Duration: (e.g., 1 week)

Links: [Dashboard] | [GitHub]

Problem

What is the real business problem? (e.g., “Revenue dropped 8% QoQ in West region.”)

Data & Method

- Data sources + cleaning steps (Power Query)

- Model design (star schema, relationships)
- Key DAX measures

Analysis & Insights

- What did you find? (2–4 punchy insights)
- Visuals that support each insight

Business Impact

- What should the business do? (actionable recommendations)
- Optional: revenue / cost / churn impact estimates

Notes

- Limitations, assumptions, privacy considerations

- `Total Sales = SUM(Sales[Amount])``
- `YoY Growth = DIVIDE([Sales]-[Sales LY],[Sales LY])``

Bullet the top 2–3 business takeaways.

6) Review Rubric (Hiring Manager View)

Clarity: Problem is specific, visuals are focused, insights are obvious.

Relevance: Project matches real business scenarios.

Technical Depth: DAX/Modeling used appropriately (not gratuitously).

Storytelling: Clear narrative from problem → insight → action.

Impact: Recommendations tied to business value.

Professionalism: README, folder structure, and privacy hygiene.
